Authentic & Bearing Fruit!

The Bible encourages us to live authentic lives. In this world we are searching to express that as being “real” or “true” to God about who we are. The world we live can sometimes recognize when another person becomes “fake” and loses the truth about who they are. At times we must remember to look at ourselves and find out if we are living “fake” lives- especially in our Christian lives! If we are trying to pretend to follow Christ, or to pretend to serve Christ, we will miss the heart of true freedom in life. The Bible says that we must also find ourselves bearing spiritual fruit out of those authentic hearts as God’s Spirit is working, playing and living in us. In other words, it is not enough to simply do what we believe to be right around here, without a Christian life being seen in and through us. It changes things, for example, to have a children’s teacher talk about being “good, little Christian boys and girls” as the teacher himself is growing in Christ, hungering for God’s Spirit each and every day! Jesus is quoted in John 15:5-8, as saying, ***“I am the Vine, you are the branches. When you’re joined with me and I with you, the relation intimate and organic, the harvest is sure to be abundant. Separated, you can’t produce a thing. Anyone who separates from me is deadwood, gathered up and thrown on the bonfire. But if you make yourselves at home with me and my words are at home in you, you can be sure that whatever you ask will be listened to and acted upon. This is how my Father shows who he is— when you produce grapes, when you mature as my disciples.”*** (The Message)
